



FISCAL SPONSORSHIP OPPORTUNITY

Friends of Sacramento Arts (FOSA), a 501c3 tax-exempt organization, is offering a partnership opportunity to serve as a fiscal sponsor for arts education and arts-related grants in the Sacramento region.

FOSA, established in 2019, works to ensure equitable access to comprehensive arts education in K-12 public schools in the greater Sacramento region.

As part of the mission, FOSA is dedicated to the arts, culture and the creative economy in the region and endeavors to provide services that will expand and strengthen the creative sector.

Fiscal sponsorships are restricted to local/regional government, corporate and private foundation grant applicants. The Sponsored Organization remains an independent entity and does not become a program of Friends of Sacramento Arts. Instead, the relationship is one of grantor–grantee and is focused on the flow of funds that are raised by the Sponsored Organization. These funds move from Friends of Sacramento Arts to the Sponsored Project structured as a grant. An administrative fee is determined by the nature of the grant and will range from 8-10%.
